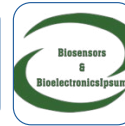
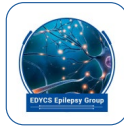

Award winners get a stipend to help their research and professional growth, as well as acknowledgment and exposure within the academic community. The prize is competitive, and it is frequently seen as a stepping stone to even greater achievement in academics. It is an excellent chance for young faculty members to enhance their careers and have a good effect on their profession.

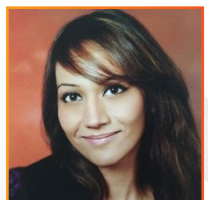
